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The “Birth” ... from a Western Austria's perspective

- 2013: Approval of a new law for teacher education in Austria, (Bundesministerium für Unterricht, Kunst und Kultur (BMUKK), 2013).
- 2013/14: Four cluster (Entwicklungsverbund) in Austria
- 2014: Accreditation with the RECC-label (regional educational competence center) for the subjects “Mathematik & Geometrie”, “Physik” and “Biologie” in Innsbruck
- 2014–2015: Curriculum development in work groups for each subject in the each cluster
- 2016: Cooperation agreement “Sekundarstufe (Allgemeinbildung)” between five institutions
- 2016: Start with the new teacher education programme in Western Austria

- Federal Ministry of Education (pedagogical colleges)
- Federal Ministry of Science, Research and Economy (universities)

Today ...

- Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research (pedagogical colleges, universities)

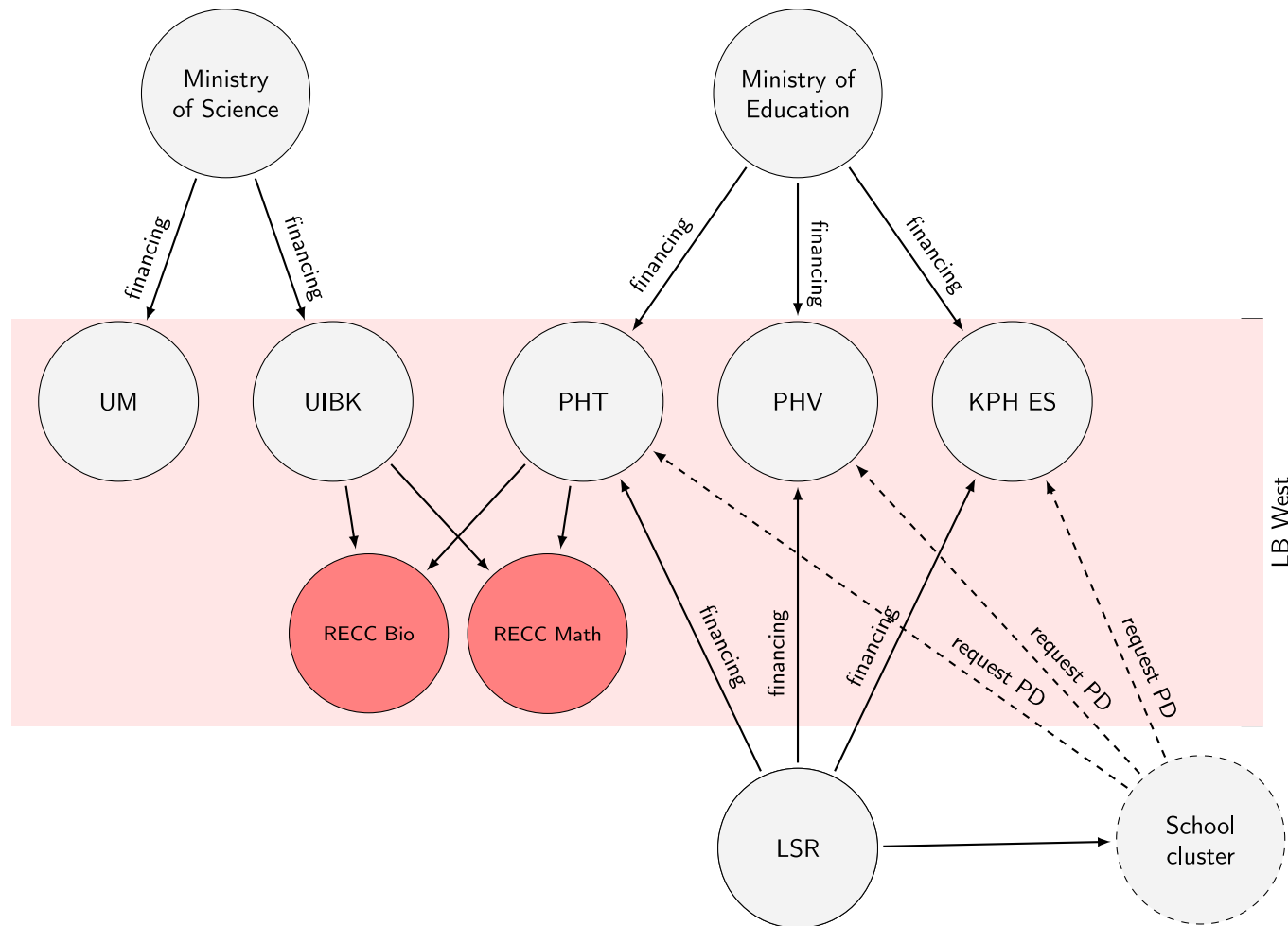
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- chance for a coherent teacher education (pre-service and in-service)
